

## SIS GRADEBOOK ACCESS

In order for parents to have access to SIS Gradebook, the school will have to have entered your e-mail address in the SIS system.

If you have already provided us with your e-mail address you can proceed to access SIS Gradebook as follows:

- Go to the LaFayette website ([www.lafayetteschools.org](http://www.lafayetteschools.org)) and click onto the Jr-Sr High School, then click "Gradebook" on the left column.
- It will take you to the page below. Enter your e-mail address then go to "New Users" to have a temporary password sent to you. Once you receive the temporary password go back to the login (below) and enter your temporary password in the "Password" box, then enter your own "New Password" and "verify New Password".

If you have not provided us with this e-mail address, please follow the steps below:

- Go to the LaFayette website ([www.lafayetteschools.org](http://www.lafayetteschools.org)) click onto Jr-Sr High School, and then Guidance.
- Click on Paula Thompson's e-mail link at the bottom of the Guidance webpage. E-mail her the e-mail address you will use to sign in on. You will receive an email back with a temporary password.
- Go back to the LaFayette website ([www.lafayetteschools.org](http://www.lafayetteschools.org))
- Click on Jr.-Sr. High School.
- Click on "Gradebook".

It will take you to the page below. Enter your e-mail address and the temporary password in the "Password" box, then enter your own "New Password" and "verify New Password".
