NOTE: Application requests must be received in the Office of the District Clerk, seven (7) days preceding the October 30, 2024 meeting of voters, if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter. If the ballot is to be delivered personally, the application must be picked up the day before the election; October 29, 2024 by 5:00 p.m.. Completed applications received after 5:00 p.m. on October 31, 2024 will require the voter to personally appear at the Office of the Clerk of the School District to receive an absentee ballot.
